**During Warm Welcome Week we're giving 'Blue Monday' a makeover. We are asking everyone to wear warm colours and get creative with pinks, oranges, reds and purples to chase the blues away this January.**

It will be fun and exciting, but with a serious message and purpose. For too many people, January is the coldest, loneliest and most challenging time of the year – in recent years the phrase 'Blue Monday' has been adopted to describe the month's lowest point. As well as taking its toll on mental health this long, dark month can be financially difficult and many households face the stark choice between heating and eating.

**Not everybody knows that there is help out there; not everybody knows there are Warm Welcome Spaces near them where they can find community, connection and belonging.**

There are currently over 5,500 Warm Welcome Spaces in the UK, forming what Gordon Brown called a 'chain of hope' across the country. For Warm Welcome Week, we want to sing it from the rooftops and raise awareness, so that everyone knows how to find their nearest space. Because we are committed, now and long-term, to a 100% pledge for a Warm Welcome for all.

**Together, in Warm Welcome Week, we will create a surge of warmth and positivity in the bluest week of the coldest month.**

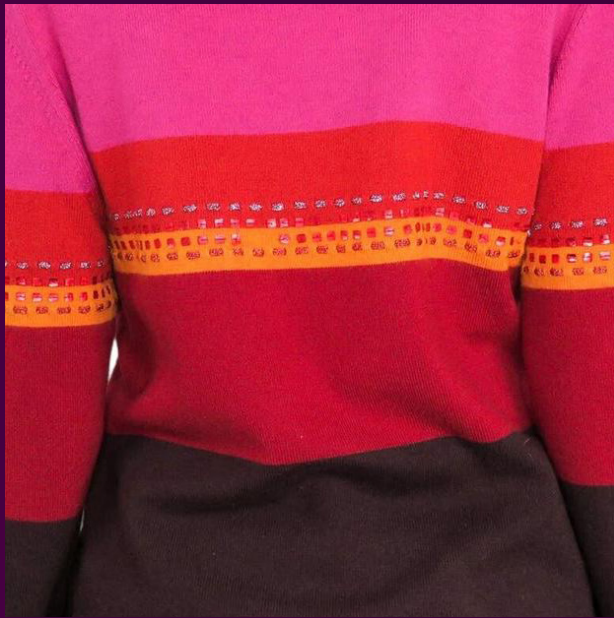

You might want to use crafts to beat those winter blues. You might rustle up a hearty and warming spiced pumpkin soup, or mark it with some hot licks on a red guitar.

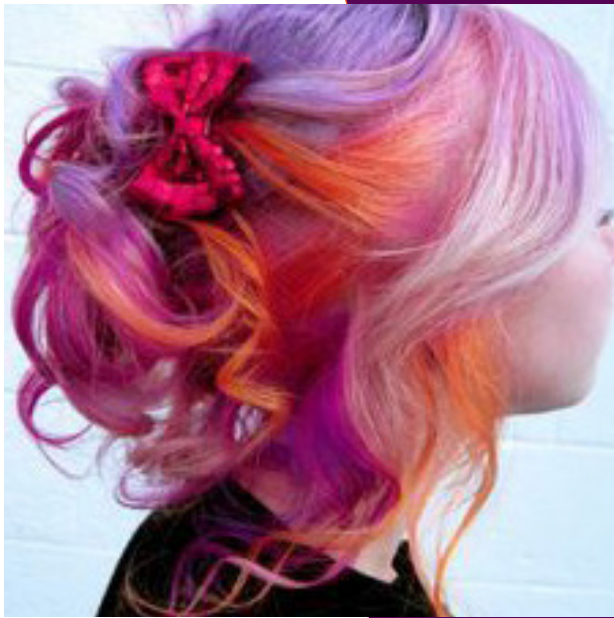
Offices - for a fun team-building day with a warming twist, form pink, orange, purple and red teams and have a sponsored day of games!

When Paul from Bicester volunteered for #WarmWelcomeWeek, he said: "I'm no Blue-Beard."



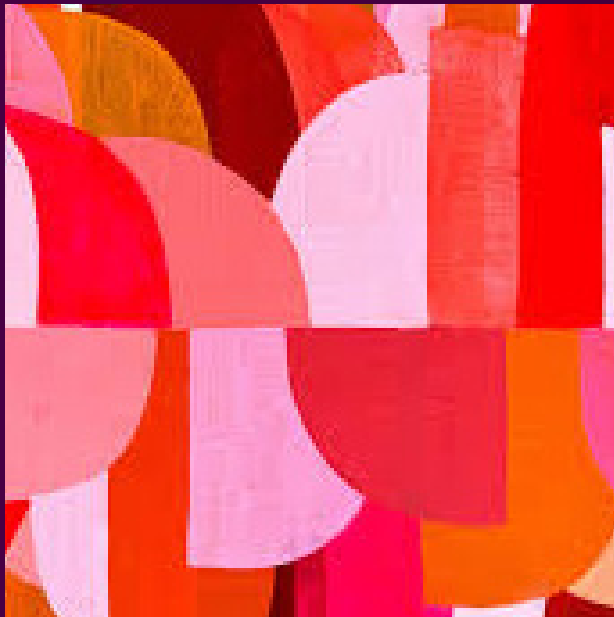

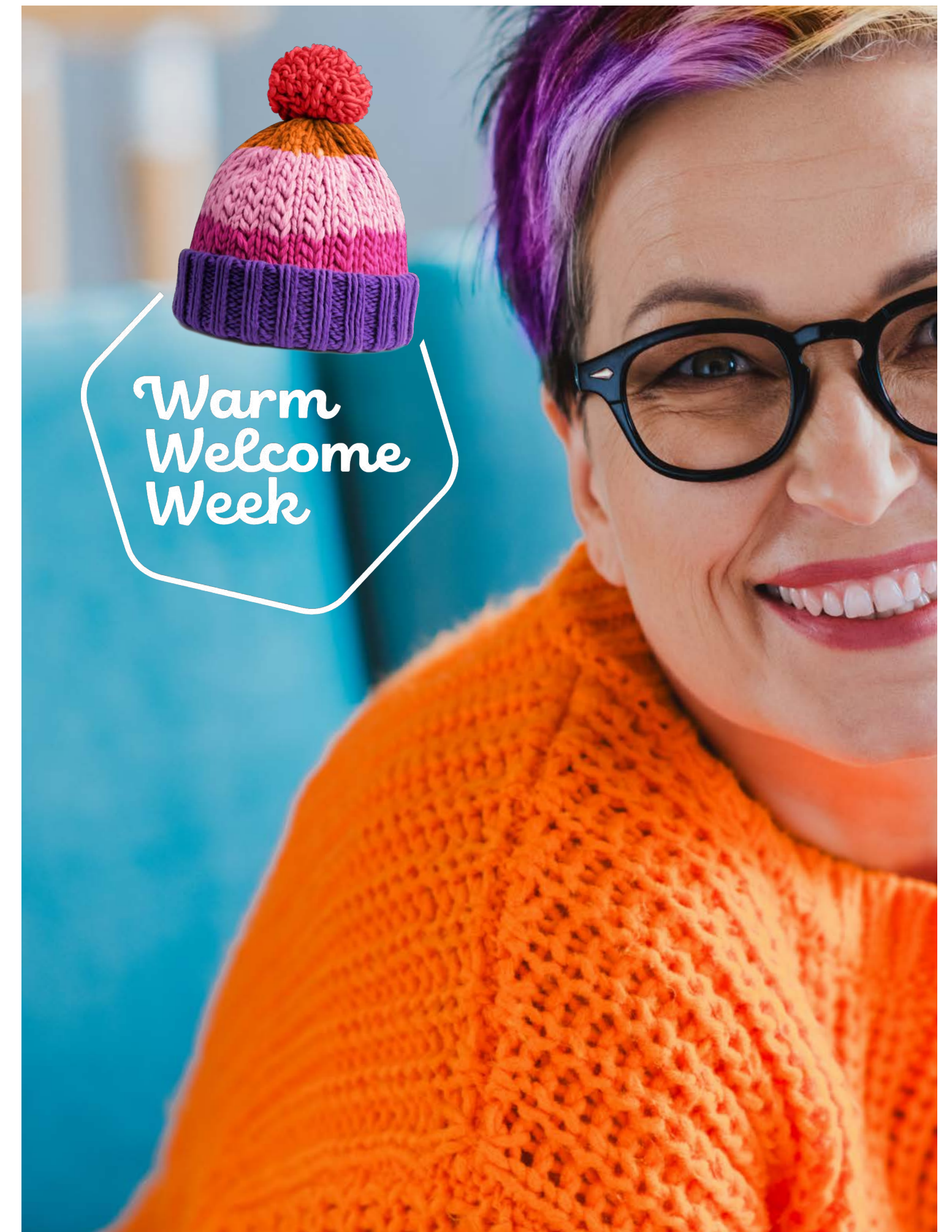
